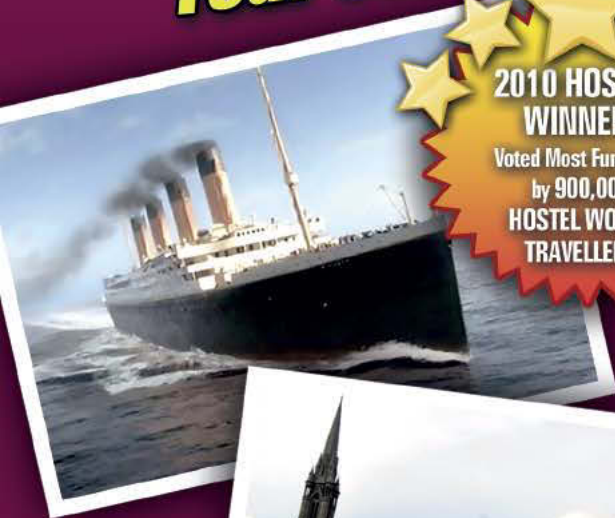

### INCLUDED..

Famed in song and story, the Irish are famous for the Blarney! Kiss the Blarney Stone and receive the 'gift of the gab' for 7

years. Situated in the battlements of the legendary Blarney Castle you shall have to bend over backwards to kiss the stone! We also visit the witches caves in the castle grounds, before having plenty of time to indulge in the tax free shopping haven of the Blarney Woollen Mills and craft shop.

### INCLUDED..

We visit Cobh the departure point for 2.5 million starving emigrants who left for America between 1848 - 1850. It was also the final port of call for the RMS Titanic. 123 passengers boarded, in all only 44 survived. The port of embarkation for men, women and children departed to penal colonies, mainly Australia. Visit the magnificent St. Coleman's Cathedral and famous Cobh Museum (Seasonal). A truly fascinating visit.

### INCLUDED..

Kinsale is the gourmet capital of Ireland with amazing restaurants and bar food. In 1601 Kinsale was the site of a battle in which English forces defeated Irish / Spanish forces lead by the O'Donnell and O'Neill clans leading to the Fight of Earts. On May 7th 1915 world history changed when a German u-boat sank the RMS Lusitania off The Old Head of Kinsale. We also have amazing views of the garrisons ! Charles Fort and James Fort.

Cork City. 2005 European city of culture and one of the top ten must see cities in the world ! (Lonely Planet) Recently visited by the Queen, the English Markets are a real highlight. A city truly to experience.
